| How does Sequoia Financial Group, LLC protect my personal information? | SFG safeguards your personal information by limiting access to only those employees of SFG and its affiliates that provide products or services to you, to those who need access to your information to service your account, to those that must come into contact with your information as part of their job responsibilities with either SFG or an affiliate of SFG, or to outside vendors who are contractually bound to protect the privacy of your non-public information. In addition, SFG maintains physical, electronic and procedural safeguards that meet applicable legal standards to protect your non-public personal information. |
| How does Sequoia Financial Group, LLC collect my personal information? | We collect your personal information, for example: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ SFG collects information furnished by you on account applications or other forms provided by you. |
| Why can't I limit all sharing? | Federal law gives you the right to limit only <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness ■ affiliates from using your information to market to you ■ sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. |
| What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else? | Your choices will apply to everyone on your account. |
| Definitions | |
| Affiliates | Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. |
| Nonaffiliates | Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. |
| Joint marketing | A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. |
